Preventive care is the most important step you can take to manage your health. Routine health exams and early detection can help prevent serious illness. The list of nationally recommended guidelines for you and your family is below. Please talk with your doctor to determine which of these are appropriate for you.

## Women:

Well visits with appropriate vaccinations
and review of medications
Breast Cancer Screening/Mammogram
Cervical Cancer Screening: Pap Smear
(ages 21-29)
Cervical Cancer Screening: HPV Screening
Pap Smear (ages 30-65)
Colorectal Cancer Screening (ages 45-75)
Chlamydia Screening (sexually active
women under 24 years of age)
Annual Physical with BMI and Blood
Pressure Screening. Cholesterol (blood
lipids) Testing may be indicated.
Annual Flu Shot
Pneumonia Vaccinations (ages 65 and
older or if you are high risk)
Nutrition and Physical Activity Counseling
Smoking Prevention/Cessation Counseling
One time Hepatitis C screening for adults
born between 1945-1965 at the direction
of your provider

Colorectal Cancer Screening (ages 45-75)
Annual Physical with BMI and Blood
Pressure Screening. Cholesterol (blood
lipids) Testing may be indicated.
Annual Flu Shot
Pneumonia Vaccinations (ages 65 and
older or if you are high risk)
Nutrition and Physical Activity Counseling
Smoking Prevention/Cessation Counseling
One time Hepatitis C screening for adults
born between 1945-1965 at the direction
of your provider
